

6. Outside Bozeman employs several people and contractors. We publish a quarterly magazine that showcases Montana's natural beauty and recreational bounty, including the Gallatin River.


7. The Yellowstone Club's unlawful discharges of water pollution into the South Fork of the West Fork of the Gallatin River adversely affects Outside Bozeman's business. Our primary revenue is from advertisers, many of whom depend on a clean, clear, unpolluted Gallatin River for their revenue and thus advertising budget.

8. Outside Bozeman's staff and I do not want to float, fish, or swim in the Yellowstone Club's water pollution.

9. The Yellowstone Club's unlawful discharges suggest that it cannot properly dispose of the wastewater they are currently producing. The Yellowstone Club should be stopped from building more vacation houses when it cannot lawfully dispose of the effluent they already produce. Allowing the Yellowstone Club to continue building and adding new sewer connections will only exacerbate the existing pollution problem and harm my conservation interest in maintaining and restoring the water quality of the Gallatin River and its tributaries.
