Thanks for your inquiry about sheep allotments in the Gravellys. Your question is timely as there has recently been action on some of these. On September 30, 2008 the Forest Supervisor closed four of these allotments that have been vacant for some time. They are Cascade-Lobo, Clover Creek, West Creek and Salway.

The remainder of the allotments in the south Gravellys are scheduled for NEPA analysis in 2011 and 2012. During that process there will be ample opportunity for public comment and involvement.
