- 5. Development in the Big Sky area is causing significant impacts to the water quality of the Gallatin River.
 - 6. The Yellowstone Club is unlawfully polluting a tributary of the Gallatin River, which has contributed to the bad algae blooms the last several summers.
 - 7. I recreate on the Gallatin River. The Yellowstone Club's illegal discharge is harming my conservation interests in protecting and restoring the water quality of the Gallatin River and the tributaries that feed it.
 - 8. A court order that stops the Yellowstone Club from continuing to discharge nitrogen pollution into the South Fork will begin to redress harms to my conservation and recreation interests. The YC should not be allowed to continue building houses and hotels when it cannot dispose of the nitrogen pollution it is already discharging.
