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TERRY CAMPBELL - REDIRECT - EXAMINATION BY MR. MEYER

- **Q**. So does that mean that the water and sewage district cannot apply for a permit?
- A. I am not sure I know the answer to that, John. I don't work in the TMDL -- or in the permitting section. I'm sorry.

 Another acronym, Total Maximum Daily Load Program. So I don't know whether or not they could obtain a permit for that reach of the stream.
- Q. So you're saying they might be able to apply for a permit if the jury decides that they are violating the Clean Water

 Act?
- 11 A. I believe if they could meet, you know, really tight water 12 quality standards, they probably could secure a permit, even if 13 it is an impaired stream, because it would be an improvement on 14 water quality over what's there. But I'm not positive of that.
- 15 **Q**. Okay.

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- 16 A. It's outside of my expertise.
- Q. The last thing you said is that the leakage standard applies when the facility is brand-new. Is that right?
- 19 A. Correct.
- 20 Q. Is doesn't apply 20 years out?
- 21 A. It does not.
- Q. And if there are tears and rips in the liner, should those be repaired 20 years out?
- 24 A. They certainly should be, yes.
